

#### **Designated Bushfire Prone Areas**

- (a) build, construct or erect or cause or permit to be built, constructed or erected on the land hereby transferred any building other than one private dwelling house (constructed of all new materials) having an area of not less than 170 square metres within the outer walls thereof (such area to be calculated by excluding the area of any carports, workshops, garages, terraces, patios, pergolas or verandahs attached to such house) provided that nothing herein contained shall prohibit the erection on the said land of a garage and/or other normal residential outbuildings where a private dwelling house is or is being erected on the said land.
- (b) build, construct or erect or cause or permit to be built, constructed or erected on the land hereby transferred any garage and/or normal residential outbuilding having a height greater than 4 metres which together have a total aggregate floor area greater than 80 square metres provided that in calculating such total aggregate area of 80 square metres, (i) The floor area of any garage which is incorporated as an integral part of the structure of a dwelling house constructed on the said land shall be ignored and , (ii) The floor area of any normal residential outbuilding with a floor area not exceeding 10 square meters shall be ignored , and further provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed as limiting the height of any garage which is incorporated as an integral part of the structure of a dwelling house constructed on the said land.




